

## HEALTH SERVICE

The health service center is the area where children receive medical care. Campers are able to receive care without disrupting the activities of other campers.

### Set-up and Operation

The health service staff assists in setting up the health service center. This area functions as an onsite “clinic” and provides treatment for all medical needs of the campers while at camp. Attention should be paid to the following areas:

1. Waiting area for campers
  - Organized with chairs and access to drinking water
2. Assessment area
  - Privacy, if needed
  - Relatively quiet
  - Easily accessible by medical staff
3. Treatment area
  - Away from main flow of health services
  - Chairs and/or bed for camper to relax
  - Electrical outlet for nebulizer and other equipment
  - Table for documentation and supplies or equipment used
4. Supply storage area
  - Organized for easy location and access to supplies
  - May be designed to be moved around the camp
5. Emergency treatment area
  - Bed
  - Emergency equipment and power source
  - Telephone access
6. Medication storage area
  - Secured when not occupied by medical staff
  - Organized for easy access to camper medications and stock medications
  - Storage for camper medications carriers when not in use
