

SITE SELECTION CONSIDERATIONS

Site specifications for each program will vary based on camp format, size, duration and programming. Some issues to consider include:

- Capacity of housing facilities for staff and campers
- Access to trained camp program staff
- Caliber of “camp” program (i.e., achievements, activities, etc.)
- Overall condition of camp facility and equipment
- Appeal of campgrounds
- Accessibility of campgrounds
- Ability to provide nutritious and appealing meals
- Refined emergency policies and procedures
- Experienced facility coordinator/director
- Overall financial viability of proposed partnership
- Length of commitment offered/required
- Experience with specialty camp programs
- Availability of facility for preferred dates of camp
- Reputation of camp within the community
