

HEALTH SERVICE CAMPER VISIT PROCEDURE

1. Ask camper to sign-in or assist the process by completing sign-in sheet
 - Name
 - Cabin
 - Date/time
 - Complaint
2. Pull chart and review past treatments, etc.
3. If visit is related to asthma, have camper complete asthma visit sheet
Remind camper to relax, “belly breathe” and sip water
4. Proceed to assessment and treatment according to standing orders
5. Primary nurse does not need to care for her own camper in the health service
6. Nurse who initiates care should complete care through discharge, whenever possible
7. Use timers for easy measurement of intervals between treatments, *campers who have been treated for asthma symptoms are reassessed in 15-minute increments.*
8. Complete SOAP note in camper chart at time of discharge
9. Place check mark next to camper name on sign in sheet when all charting is complete
10. Health service staff should try to achieve the following:
 - Camper education while treatment is dispensed
 - Quick, thorough assessment and resolution of the problems
 - Encourage camper to return to camp activities as soon as possible
 - Complete all documentation at time of visit
 - Evaluate “ frequent visitors” for possible desire to stay in security of health service area
