Thermometer(s) and covers (digital oral ones are cheap and accurate)
Blood pressure cuff(s) – child through adult extra large
Oto-ophthalmoscope and ear tips of various sizes
Stethoscope
Bandage scissors
Tweezers
Suture pack (of suturing is possible)
Plastic buckets for soaking wounds or emesis
Nebulizer tubing and medication cups
Nebulizers
Oxygen tank with valve
Telephone
Kitchen timers

General supplies

Books for reading during treatments

Wound care supplies

Cleaning solution (antibacterial soap or hibiclens)
Alcohol prep pads
Peroxide
2" rolled gauze
3" rolled gauze
2x2 gauze sponges
Paper towel
Disposable gloves – medium and large
Betadine solution
Sterile gauze pads
Band-aids – various sizes
Non-stick pads (telfa)
Paper tape
Adhesive tape
Suture materials/Dermabond
Surgical scrub brushes (for wound cleaning)
Saline solution for cleaning and irrigating wounds
Cotton tipped applicators
Cotton balls
Calamine lotion
Sunscreen
Aloe Vera lotion
Triple antibiotic ointment (non prescription)
Hydrocortisone cream (non prescription)
Vaseline
Steri-strips and benzoine
Tampons
Peri-pads
Needles – 20, 24, 26 gauges
Syringes – disposable TB, 3cc, 5cc, 10cc
Kitchen sponges and ziplock bags for ice packs
Hydrogen peroxide
Rubbing alcohol
Gloves, sterile and non sterile, disposable

Medications

Medications should be kept in pharmacy area but a small amount of acetaminophen, albuterol, saline, Sudafed, Maalox (or Tums), and benedryl may be kept in stock for health service use.
